



Riding Tasks – Certificate 2

<u>No.</u>	<u>Tasks</u>	<u>Pass</u>	<u>Comment</u>
<u>Using halter and one rein only</u>			
1	Mount horse bareback unassisted from both sides.		
2	Walk, trot and canter your horse bareback one circle in each gate in both directions. Stop and back up five steps using your seat only.		
<u>With saddle and halter with one rein</u>			
3	Obtain lateral flexion both sides using your seat only		
4	Yield hindquarters for three steps both sides without reins		
5	Side-pass your horse to the left and the right for three steps. On both sides side-pass both to the one rein and away from one rein.		
6	Perform a turn on the hindquarters for a half rotation showing 'support' rein and 'direct rein' positions separately. Show both directions.		
<u>Saddle and halter with two reins</u>			
7	Back your horse up a few steps and, whilst in time with the horse's steps, perform a forequarter yield one quarter of a circle. Perform four such manoeuvres to the right and the repeat for the left.		
8	Walk your horse in a small circle to the left and the right showing flexion through the body and vertical flexion of the head.		

9 Trot your horse in a larger circle to the left and the right showing flexion through the body and vertical flexion of the head.

10 Canter your horse in a large circle to the left and the right showing flexion through the body and vertical flexion of the head.

11 Canter your horse for three circles in both directions, jumping a jump at least 60 cm in height

--	--

Saddle, halter and training stick

12 Using your training stick only, obtain later flexion on both sides.

--	--

13 Using your training stick to maintain lateral flexion, yield your hindquarters three steps and finish with the flex. Repeat on other side.

--	--

14 Walk your horse in a square shaped pattern. At each corner of the square perform an indirect rein using your training stick only to turn your horse. Ride both left and right. The stop and back up five steps using your seat only.

--	--

15 Canter your horse three circles to the left, indirect rein to a trot. Trot through the center of the circle, throwing the rein to the off side of his neck. Then canter depart and canter three circles to the right. Indirect rein to a trot. Trot through the center of the circle throwing the rein to the near side of his neck. Then canter three circles to the left again. Stop and back up five steps.
